**ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN
JOHNSON & WALES UNIVERSITY
AND THE
AMERICAN HOTEL & LODGING ASSOCIATION'S
EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTE (AH&LA/EI)**

This document defines the terms through which students can make a smooth transition from secondary education into post secondary education. This document describes advantages that students will have at Johnson & Wales University as a result of their successful participation in the American Hotel & Lodging Association's Educational Institute Lodging Management program.

Stipulations of the Agreement:

- Students are expected to complete the required admissions application form and must submit an official high school transcript. Upon acceptance to Johnson & Wales University, a student will be eligible for consideration of the articulation agreement.
- Students must forward a letter of recommendation from their lodging instructor.
- Students must have complete and submit a copy of the **AH&LA/EI Lodging Management certificate** to be considered for transfer credits.
- Students must earn a grade equal to 80 or above in the Lodging Management program.
- Students who complete the above stipulations may earn the following college credits depending on their chosen major.
