
Specifically, under this agreement students may apply for the following courses:


<u>Course Number</u>	<u>Course Description</u>	<u>Number of Credits</u>

The awarding of credits shall be based upon review/evaluation of the following:

1. Student must receive a grade of "B" or higher upon completion of the AOHT program.
2. Student must graduate from high school.
3. Student must be admitted as a degree-seeking student within the Hotel Management within 24 months (2 years) of high school graduation.
4. Student must meet all other Kendall College Admissions' requirements.

This agreement will become effective upon signing of the parties listed below and shall remain in effect without interruption unless changes in the curriculum are presented prior to implementation so that the impact upon the agreement can be evaluated. Furthermore, this agreement shall be listed on the AH&LA-EI website and any other state directory accessible to LMP high school students.
