Based upon mutual concern for the continued growth of students pursuing lodging-related pathways and in an effort to provide a continuing articulated program that builds on past learning experience and eliminates unnecessary duplication of instruction, we mutually subscribe to the following:

- 1. Students who have completed the Lodging Management Program (LMP) with a minimum grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale (3.75 on a 5.0 scale) and have passed the required LMP exams, will be given the following college credits, after submitting proof of completion to the ATC Registrar:


- 3. Students must be admitted as degree-seeking student at ATC within 24 months of high school graduation.
